

# Spring and Summer Athletic Practices and Clinics

Washington Interscholastic Activities Association (WIAA) allows teams to practice from the day after the last WIAA sanctioned event in Spring, to the first day of August. There are no practices allowed during the period between the first day of August, and the first day of practices allowed for fall specific sports.

## Spring (Post WIAA Season) athletics

Roosevelt will have practices for the following sports from June 1, 2010 to June 22, 2010.

**Football**

**Basketball, Boys and Girls**

**Volleyball**

All practices during this time are optional, and participation is **NOT** required to be a part of a team during the school year. These practices are opportunities for athletes to work with coaches on skills development and training.

To be eligible for these organized practices, **current** students must:

- 1) Complete athletic paperwork for the upcoming year, including physicals, concussion information, and other required paperwork. Athletic forms can be found on this website.
- 2) Payment of all fees and fines. This must be done prior to being issued any equipment or being allowed to participate in practices.
- 3) No student is allowed to participate unless cleared completely, in writing, from the main office.
- 4) Students may not turn out for more than one sport at a time. Football helmet fund and summer camp rental equipment fees are non refundable upon issuance of equipment

**Incoming 8<sup>th</sup> grade students** are eligible to participate in these practices, providing the following criteria are met:

- 1) The student must be a registered and enrolled at Roosevelt for the 2010-2011 school year.
- 2) Students cannot participate until June 1
- 3) Students must complete all required athletic paperwork, and pay all fees and fines, prior to the start of any practices.

4) Students cannot leave their current school classes early in the day, or miss any classes to participate in any athletic practices during the Spring open contact period.

5) Students may not turn out for more than one sport at a time. Football helmet reconditioning and summer camp rental equipment fees are non refundable upon issuance of equipment

## Summer Practice Information
